All Grade 12 students write external provincial diploma leaving examinations administered by Alberta Education. They are marked in Alberta; results are received approximately one month after writing.

Our first IB graduates were from the class of 2019. The class of 2020 had 6 students attempt the full IB Diploma and 17 others did individual courses.


### Class of 2020

### **Our Covid-19 Response**

On January 27th, 2020 the Macau Government closed schools; Feb 3rd, 2020 we commenced online learning for all classes and our extracurricular activities (ECAs) were suspended. The leaving exams from Alberta Education and from the IBO were cancelled. On May 4th we resumed regular face-to-face lessons without ECAs and completed our school year. We are confident that the grades students received were indicative of their mastery of each subject. On Sept 1st, 2020 we continued as normally with some ECAs restricted.

### **Our Academics**

High school encompasses Grades 10 - 12. The school year runs on a linear system from September to June. Every student takes 8 classes on a 2-day schedule with an advisory block on Wednesdays. Interim grades are available in mid-February and mid-April with final grades including standard exam results from Alberta available at the end of July. Transcripts can be downloaded from Parchment or BridgeU, emailed directly from Academic Counsellors, uploaded by students, or couriered as paper copies.

### **Alberta Graduation Requirements**

**Bolded** courses below are required for the Alberta High School Diploma. Students are required to complete a minimum of 100 credits, 20 of which must be at the 30-level. They must also complete at least 10 credits of hands-on courses, such as a language, an art, or one of the additional courses below.

Some courses are streamed to -1, -2, or -3, where -1 is the most academically rigorous stream. Most universities consider 5 applicable 30-level courses for admission offers (-1 and -2 courses are recongized worldwide). Most courses are 5 credits each; some half-courses are 3 credits. Courses with an asterisk (\*) are made up of 5 different modules at each successive grade level. Each module is 1 credit and is reported individually on transcripts.

### **Grading Details**

GPAs are normally reported on a 100%, unweighted scale. Letter conversions can be found on all transcripts. They encompass final marks from grades 10 and 11. For the class of 2021, the highest GPA is 93.5%, the mean is 78.3% and the lowest is 61.3%. There are 56 students in the class.

TIS does not routinely rank students. Students do not routinely take the SAT or ACT.
